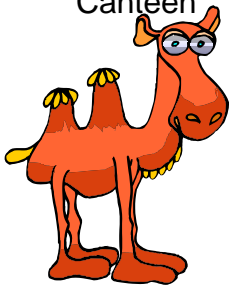

"Join the Journey!" in 2007-2008 as we study the book of Genesis! This is not just a journey of Children's Bible Quizzing . . . it is a journey into the beginning of creation, the beginning of the Bible, back to where it all began. The theme is designed to follow God's journey with mankind from the very beginning and to help children learn how they fit into the story.

How to Use the Theme:

- Create a bulletin board using "Join the Journey!" as the title. Include a timeline on the board. During each "Dig Site," add a picture or visual representation of the lesson to the timeline.
- Decorate your classroom, competition rooms, and district quizzes around the theme. Use pictures of creation, the Ark, and other visuals from the lessons.
- Encourage children to keep a journal of their "journey" as they study the book of Genesis.
- Lead children on a "journey" each week to their next "Dig Site." This could be done through mazes, scavenger hunts, follow the leader, and more!
- Bring a suitcase (Dr. Digalot's suitcase) to the "Dig Site" every week. Inside the suitcase, have an object that relates to the study of the week.
- Be creative! There are many ways to use "Join the Journey!," Dr. Digalot, his famous suitcase, and Canteen, the camel, in your 2007-08 quiz year.
