**From I-70** get off at Ohio Street exit go South approximately 5 miles. The Church will be on the left hand side of the road. Some of the lights that you will go through are Iron, then Crawford, and then Republic. Right after Republic the Church will be about a block and a half on your left.

**From I-35** get off at Magnolia if you are coming the **South**. Take a right (go east) and go to Ohio Street and take a left (north). The Church will be approximately 2 miles on your right. It is one block past Cloud Street.

**From I-35** get off at Crawford if you are coming from the **North**. Go left (east) and you will go through lights on main intersections such as Broadway, Ninth Street, and Sante Fe. When you get to Ohio Street take a right (South) and go approximately a mile and a half. The Church will be on the left hand side of the road.

Quizzer to be given Reference and first 5 words of the verse**

- E5:1-2 Be imitators of God, therefore, as dearly loved children and live a life of love, just as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us as a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God.
- E5:21 Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ.
- E5:24-25 Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives should submit to their husbands in everything. Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her
- E6:1 Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right.
- E6:2-3 "Honor your father and mother"--which is the first commandment with a promise--"that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth."
- E6:4 Fathers, do not exasperate your children; instead, bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord.
- E6:7 Serve wholeheartedly, as if you were serving the Lord, not men,
- E6:10 Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power.
- E6:13 Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand.
- Philippians**
- P1:6 being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.
- P1:9-11 And this is my prayer: that your love may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight, so that you may be able to discern what is best and may be pure and blameless until the day of Christ, filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ--to the glory and praise of God.
- P1:21 For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain.
- P2:3 Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves.
- P2:4 Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others.
- P2:5-7 Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus: Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.
- P2:8 And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient to death--even death on a cross!
- P2:9-11 Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
- P2:13 for it is God who works in you to will and to act according to his good purpose.
- P2:14 Do everything without complaining or arguing,
- P3:7 But whatever was to my profit I now consider loss for the sake of Christ.
- P3:8 What is more, I consider everything a loss compared to the surpassing greatness of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whose sake I have lost all things. I consider them rubbish, that I may gain Christ
- P3:10-11 I want to know Christ and the power of his resurrection and the fellowship of sharing in his sufferings, becoming like him in his death, and so, somehow, to attain to the resurrection from the dead.
- P3:12 Not that I have already obtained all this, or have already been made perfect, but I press on to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me.
- P3:13-14 Brothers, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.
- P4:4 Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!
- P4:6-7 Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.
- P4:8 Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable--if anything is excellent or praiseworthy--think about such things.
- P4:12 I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want.
- P4:13 I can do everything through him who gives me strength.
- P4:19 And my God will meet all your needs according to his glorious riches in Christ Jesus.
- Colossians**
- C1:13 For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves,
- C1:16 For by him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things were created by him and for him.
