Luke 11:9-10	"So I say to you: Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives; he who seeks finds; and to him who knocks, the door will be opened.		
Luke 11:13	If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!"		
Luke 11:28	He replied, "Blessed rather are those who hear the word of God and obey it."		
Luke 12:8-9	"I tell you, whoever acknowledges me before men, the Son of Man will also acknowledge him before the angels of God. But he who disowns me before men will be disowned before the angels of God.		
Luke 12:15	Then he said to them, "Watch out! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; a man's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions."

You will quiz over Exodus (Dig Sites 1-16) using Teen
Quizzing equipment and rules.
Top 3 Quizzers will receive Trophies. All those participating
will receive awards.

For those not familiar with Teen Quizzing here is the basic format:

The Team-- A quiz team consists of up to 5 quizzers. In this case we will be quizzing in team format but there will not be an actual team.

The Officials--The quizmaster reads the questions, rules on the answers. The scorekeeper records the points awarded to and/or deducted from each quizzers and team.

The Quiz; the length of a quiz is 20 questions. Once the quizmaster has finished reading the question, quizzers have 5 seconds to jump. If no one jumps, the quizmaster will read the answer and go on to the next question. If a quizzers jumps. he/she will be recognized by the quizmaster. The quizzers has 30 seconds to answer the question.

Bonus Questions If the answer is incorrect the quizzers on the other team in the corresponding seat gets the entire question as a bonus question. (This will be done to show format only)

Quiz Outs: Four correct answers to toss-up questions by a quizzers is a quiz-out. If the quizzers does this without any errors the quizzers earns 10 additional points.

Error Outs: Three errors (incorrect answers to toss-up questions) by a quizzers is an error-out. The quizzers receives a 10-point penalty for the third error.

The equipment: Teen quizzing uses electronic jump seats. We have some we use with laptop computers. The quizzers sit on pads and jump when they want to answer the question. The first person to jump will have the opportunity to answer the question.
