<b>Luke 6:5</b>	Then Jesus said to them, "The Son of Man is Lord of the Sabbath."		
<b>Luke 6:20</b>	Looking at his disciples, he said: "Blessed are you who are poor, for yours is the kingdom of God.		
<b>Luke 6:21</b>	Blessed are you who hunger now, for you will be satisfied. Blessed are you who weep now, for you will laugh.		
<b>Luke 6:22-23</b>	Blessed are you when men hate you, when they exclude you and insult you and reject your name as evil, because of the Son of Man. "Rejoice in that day and leap for joy, because great is your reward in heaven. For that is how their fathers treated the prophets.		
<b>Luke 6:27-28</b>	"But I tell you who hear me: Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you.		
<b>Luke 6:31</b>	Do to others as you would have them do to you.		
<b>Luke 6:35-36</b>	But love your enemies, do good to them, and lend to them without expecting to get anything back. Then your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High, because he is kind to the ungrateful and wicked. Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful.		
<b>Luke 6:37</b>	"Do not judge, and you will not be judged. Do not condemn, and you will not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven.		
<b>Luke 6:38</b>	Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you."		
<b>Luke 6:45</b>	The good man brings good things out of the good stored up in his heart, and the evil man brings evil things out of the evil stored up in his heart. For out of the overflow of his heart his mouth speaks.		
<b>Luke 7:9</b>	When Jesus heard this, he was amazed at him, and turning to the crowd following him, he said, "I tell you, I have not found such great faith even in Israel."		
<b>Luke 7:22</b>	So he replied to the messengers, "Go back and report to John what you have seen and heard: The blind receive sight, the lame walk, those who have leprosy are cured, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the good news is preached to the poor.		
<b>Luke 7:28</b>	I tell you, among those born of women there is no one greater than John; yet the one who is least in the kingdom of God is greater than he."		
<b>Luke 8:16-17</b>	"No one lights a lamp and hides it in a jar or puts it under a bed. Instead, he puts it on a stand, so that those who come in can see the light. For there is nothing hidden that will not be disclosed, and nothing concealed that will not be known or brought out into the open.		
<b>Luke 8:21</b>	He replied, "My mother and brothers are those who hear God's word and put it into practice."		
<b>Luke 8:25</b>	"Where is your faith?" he asked his disciples. In fear and amazement they asked one another, "Who is this? He commands even the winds and the water, and they obey him."		
<b>Luke 8:50</b>	Hearing this, Jesus said to Jairus, "Don't be afraid; just believe, and she will be healed."		
<b>Luke 9:20</b>	"But what about you?" he asked. "Who do you say I am?" Peter answered, "The Christ of God."		
<b>Luke 9:23-24</b>	Then he said to them all: "If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me. For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for me will save it.		
<b>Luke 9:25</b>	What good is it for a man to gain the whole world, and yet lose or forfeit his very self?		
<b>Luke 9:47-48</b>	Jesus, knowing their thoughts, took a little child and had him stand beside him. Then he said to them, "Whoever welcomes this little child in my name welcomes me; and whoever welcomes me welcomes the one who sent me. For he who is least among you all--he is the greatest."		
<b>Luke 9:62</b>	Jesus replied, "No one who puts his hand to the plow and looks back is fit for service in the kingdom of God."		
<b>Luke 10:2</b>	He told them, "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field.		
<b>Luke 10:20</b>	However, do not rejoice that the spirits submit to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven."		
<b>Luke 10:21</b>	At that time Jesus, full of joy through the Holy Spirit, said, "I praise you, Father, Lord of heaven		

and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and learned, and revealed them to little children. Yes, Father, for this was your good pleasure.
